Horticultural Classes

Rules & Instructions

1. Classes are open to all growers. Entry tags are available from Phyllis Mueller -545-1752 or at the show.
2. Only true lilies (genus liliium) having scaly bulbs are permitted.
3. Each entry must be grown outdoors without protection.
4. An exhibitor may make more than one entry in any class provided that each entry is of a different cultivar or variety.
5. Containers for individual stems and vase entries will be supplied.
6. a. The Classification Committee will assist an exhibitor with labeling and placement.
b. Classes may be subdivided to cultivar, color, etc., to facilitate judging, at the discretion of the Show Committee.
7. A lily stem must have one flower open to be judged. Exhibitors are encouraged to leave pollen on the anthers. Doubles must have two open flowers
8. Entries must be free from diseases, insects and dirt. No artificial plant material is allowed. No noxious or endangered plant materials allowed.
9. All entries must remain in place until close of the show.
10. Winners will be awarded ribbons, trophies or gifts.
11. Section E will be judged unofficially and not count towards the sweepstake award.
12. Donations will be accepted for stems not claimed by Exhibitor prior to the close of the show on July 16th.

Judging

1. Entries not made in accordance to Show Schedule are automatically eliminated.
2. The official NALS scale of points is to be used to evaluate specimens entered in horticultural classes except for sections D, and E
Condition..... 30
Vigor..... 20
Placement on stem.....20
Substance of flowers..... 10
Form of flowers..... 10
Color of flowers..... .10
3. The Lighty System will be used for judging Classes D &E.
Breeding advancement will be evaluated as follows:
Vigor..... 20
Placement of flowers..... 20
Substance of flowers..... 20
Form of flowers..... 20
Color of flowers..... 20
A first place entry must score high in at least two attributes.
4. In classes for three of same species, variety or cultivar utmost consideration will be given to uniformity.
5. In judging “Best in Show”, stems from multiple stalks classes may be considered.
6. A Judge’s decision is final and may not change without the consensus of the Judges, preferably prior to show opening to the public.
